Reservations

- **Face coverings are recommended for scheduled programs and events that fall between 7am-5:30pm Mon-Fri due to children's nature programs happening throughout that time; we highly recommend following CDC guidance.** Wearing a well-fitted mask along with vaccination, self-testing, and physical distancing, helps protect you and others by reducing the chance of spreading COVID-19.
- We have resumed regular room capacity for scheduled programs and reservations.
- Credit issued due to COVID-19 may be used any time by 12/31/22 for any date that falls prior to 12/31/23. Unused credit will expire on 12/31/22.
